





## Accent 800 – Connecting to the Internet via the Internal Computer Quick Reference Guide

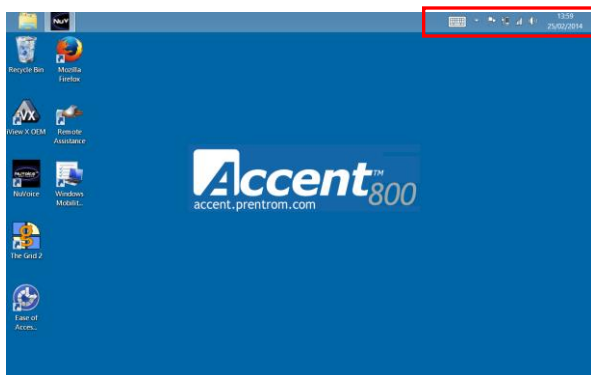
The **Accent 800** is a Communication Aid but also has computer capabilities. If you wish to have Internet Access you must firstly make sure you have a wireless internet connection. If you haven't, you will need to call your internet service provider for more information.

### **WI-FI FOR A WIRELESS CONNECTION**

For a wireless internet connection you must connect to a Wireless local area network (**WLAN**).



1. Select the **TOOLS/HOME**  key on the front of the case
2. Select the **HIDE/SHOW NUVOICE** key  from the **SOFTKEYS** menu
3. The Accent Windows desktop will be displayed



Accent 800 version 1.08 & Above

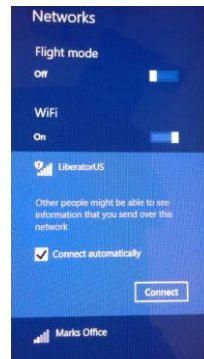
4. The Wi-Fi icon should be displayed in the upper right side of the task bar. It should have an asterisk beside it, indicating it is on, but not connected.



5. Tap on the Wi-Fi icon
6. A list of available networks to connect to and their signal strength will be displayed. If you are at home, your home network should be visible. If you are at school or work, you will probably see more networks to choose from



7. Tap the network you want to connect to.



8. Tap **Connect**.
9. Follow the directions on your display. You may have to enter a network key or password.

*When you are connected, the Wi-Fi icon in the task bar changes to bright white.*

10. Exit the menu and go to the Internet to test the connection. The Internet Explorer icon



is in the top left corner of your device screen. (Most vocabulary programs also have the Internet Explorer and other web browser icons within the Computer Pages.)

### **WHAT ANTI-VIRUS SOFTWARE SHOULD I LOAD ON MY Accent 800?**

If you intend to use the **Accent 800's** internal computer we can confirm that the Microsoft anti-virus software, **WINDOWS DEFENDER** is installed and activated and will not impact the **Accent 800's** performance.

If you decide to load different anti-virus software, you will want to choose one with caution and select one that uses minimal resources. Always review the **System Requirements** before loading. Certain **Anti-Virus Software** will make the device run slowly due to scanning and updates being done in the background.
